Dear Civil Court of Aalborg:

I received your fax dated today and thank you for same. I sent a fax to Jens Saebo this morning.

Please clear up whether the court meeting is scheduled on Monday July 6th or Tuesday July 7th.

Since she has been in Denmark, Mrs. Chesnut has specifically threatened to take Christian into hiding if any legal action is taken against her. Mrs. Chesnut is aware that Mr. Chesnut has instituted a Hague proceeding to obtain the return of Christian to his habitual residence. Mr. Chesnut believes Mrs. Chesnut when she says that she will go into hiding with Christian. I urge you in the strongest way I can to immediately take action to have Christian Chesnut taken into protective custody pending the outcome of the court case. Otherwise, Christian will be in the underground before the scheduled court meeting. It is my understanding that Rule 4 (B) of "The Operation of the Central Authority for Denmark" allows a court to decide that a child should stay "in a place chosen by the local social security authority until the court has reached a final decision." (See Section 17 of the International Child Abduction Act). Mrs. Chesnut has been planning this abduction for a long time. It is unlikely that she is going to produce Christian at a court meeting on Monday of next week, Tuesday of next week, or any other day.
